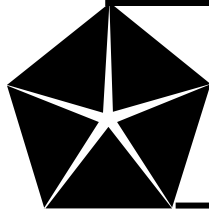
If you normally pay your club dues at the show in July, and you haven't renewed yet, this will be your last newsletter.
