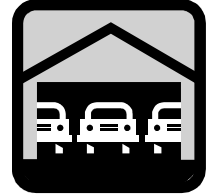

It’s car show time - AGAIN! The rescheduled 26th Annual “Fun In The Sun” All Mopar Car Show will be held on Saturday, September 20 at Chilhowee Park. The set up for this show is a little different from July’s show. We will be using only the pond side of the park. The midway side, including the tunnel, is rented out and is **unavailable** for us to use. Everyone - swap, car corral, car entrants, and general admission will enter from the Lake Side Drive entrance. There will be signs on Magnolia Ave. directing the cars to this entrance. Mike along with Chilhowee Park security will be helping to direct everyone that comes in the show area. Registration will be along the fence by the Horner Hamilton Theater. Trailer parking will be behind the Jacob’s Building and on the Zoo side of the pond. Swap/Car Corral area is the same. General admission parking is on the gravel area to the left as you enter the gate and in front of the Golden Gloves Arena and the Horner Hamilton Theater. Model Car/T-Shirt sales/and the 50/50 ticket sales will be set up on the hill by the bandstand. The Jacob’s Building (south side) will be open for use of the bathrooms along with several port-a-johns around the show area. The Day of Show Job list still needs workers for the show. It is so very important that club members attend this Saturday’s regular club meeting at the Rescue Squad and then the worker’s meeting on Thursday, September 18 at the park. If you are unable to attend either of these meetings but want to work the show, please e-mail me ASAP. Set up on show day is at 6:00am. All club members not showing their cars are asked to enter the show area and park on the gravel parking area behind the First Aid Station. If you are showing your car, please park it around the flag pole area. All members are asked to wear their ETM t-shirts the day of the show. If you need one, I will have them at both meetings. 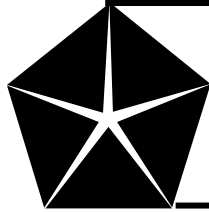

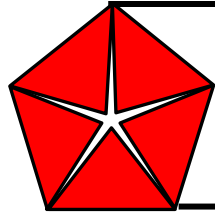
