East Tennessee Mopars Car Club Elections

Duties:

President - shall preside at all ETM meetings and functions, will have the power to decide questions of equal division, and have all powers, duties, and responsibilities usually vested in the President of any organization. Duties include but not limited to setting the agenda for the monthly meeting, set up meeting places, activities/events for the club, correspond with other officers when necessary, and to represent the ETM club at any show, cruise in, event/activity.

Vice-President - shall serve as aide to the President, and shall perform the duties of the President in the absence of the President. Is a member of the Executive Board and Car Show Committee

Secretary - shall keep in writing the minutes and attendance of all regular monthly ETM meetings and any meetings of the ETM Executive Board/ Car Show Committee. Is a member of the Executive Board and Car Show Committee

Treasurer - shall be responsible for the funds of the East Tennessee Mopars Car Club, maintaining funds in the ETM bank account, collect all dues and keep a record of them, pay all bills pertaining to ETM club matters, report to ETM members a financial report as necessary. Prepare yearly all required tax forms. Prepare yearly all required state forms. Is a member of the Executive Board and Car Show Committee

Membership Director - shall be responsible for contacting members when their membership is up for renewal. Have application forms available at all ETM meetings/functions/events. Will report to the club President any new members.

Car Show Director - shall be responsible for all aspects of the "Fun in the Sun" All Mopar Car Show. To include but not limited to location, sponsorships, insurance, t-shirts, dash plaques, DJ, special quests, judges/judging, Day of Show jobs. Car Show Director will report to the club President. Also report at all monthly meetings. Is a member of the Car Show Committee

Newsletter Editor - shall be responsible for publishing and distributing the East Tennessee Mopars monthly newsletter: Mopar Muscle. Will report to the club President.

ETM Board Members (up to 3) - shall be responsible for attending the regular ETM monthly meetings and also to attend to Executive Board Meetings to help set the agenda for the next regular ETM meeting. To make recommendations and advice club members on club decisions

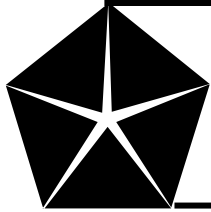
